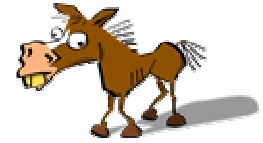

to his faithful, to those who turn to him in their hearts.

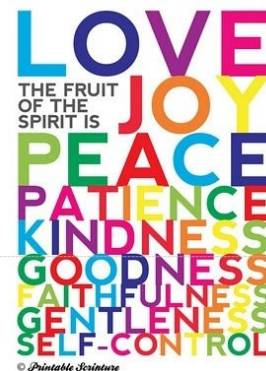
**All Surely his salvation is at hand for those who fear him,
