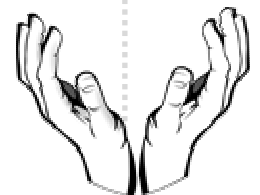
As you know, we are aiming to make a display of poppies to mark the end of the First World War.

In the land of the living.

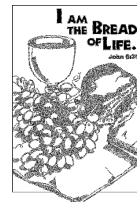
