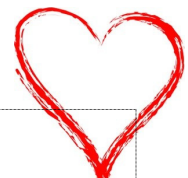

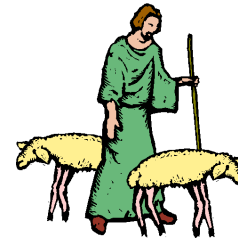
Leader The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.
