and you renew the face of the ground.

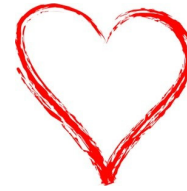
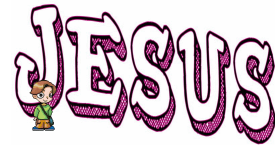
**All May the glory of the Lord endure for ever;

I will sing praise to my God while I have being.**

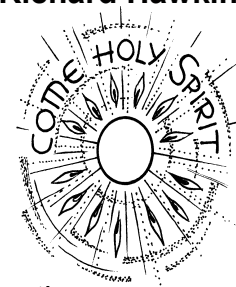
