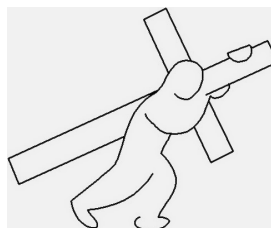

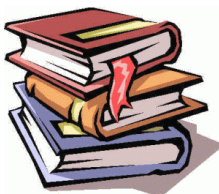

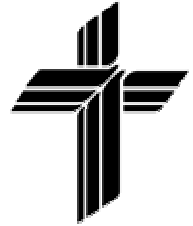
An Invite - Robert 'Reschid' Stanley book launches
